SBI Pharmaceuticals Opens a Representative Office in Bahrain

SBI Pharmaceuticals Co., Ltd. (Head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Yoshitaka Kitao), a subsidiary of SBI Holdings, Inc., engaged in research and development of pharmaceuticals, cosmetics and health foods using 5-aminolevulinic acid (5-ALA), opens a representative office in Manama, the capital of Bahrain.

As announced in the press release on April 13, 2012, titled "Notice on the Agreement with Bahrain Government for the Promotion of the 5-ALA Business" SBI Pharmaceuticals reached a basic agreement and concluded a memorandum of understanding with the Bahrain Government on the close cooperation for promoting the research and development of 5-ALA and its diffusion in Bahrain and GCC (*1).

SBI Pharmaceuticals officially acquired a permit of opening a representative office from Bahrain Economic Development Board on October 9, 2012. The opening of Bahrain Representative Office will enhance closer relationship to the Bahrain Government, and Bahrain will be SBI Pharmaceuticals' hub for the research and development of pharmaceuticals in the Middle East and North Africa region (MENA).

SBI Pharmaceuticals continues to explore the various possibilities of 5-ALA and endeavor to conduct R&D on it jointly with partners in Japan and abroad, aiming to contribute to the health of as many people as possible in the world.
